Please, no smoking in the house.

Things to bring.

1. Food . We have a fairly stocked pantry with sugar, flour, spices, etc.
2. There is a propane gas grill on the second level. You may want to bring your own tank. Please move the grill away from the wall. The heat will melt the siding.
3. Extra towels (beach towels), sun block lotion, etc.
4. Personal toiletries.
5. Books, magazines, etc.
6. There are several TV's, some with a VCR and or a DVD player. We have a decent collection of family movies. We also have DishNetwork.
7. There is no long distance service, so bring a calling card if you need to make long distance calls. Cell phones are not reliable in Horseshoe.

Things to do when you get there.

1. Make sure the water is turned on. Turn on the water at the meter. The meter is located next to the white spigot on the NE corner of the property (by the power pole). There is also a valve on the column with all of the utilities leading top the house.
2. Turn on the hot water heater switch. It's down the hallway from the kitchen on the right across from the bathroom.
3. Plug in all the TV's and other electronic appliances.
4. Sheets and blankets for the second bedroom and the living room futon are in the bedroom closet.
5. Two small air mattresses are behind the bunk/futon in the second bedroom.
6. Extra trash bags are under the kitchen sink.
7. If not on the bathroom shelves, the extra towels and linens are in the downstairs laundry room in the dryer.
8. If you want blue crabs at your next meal, load the traps (chicken pieces and parts work well) and set them along the seawall.

Things to do when you leave.

1. Please wash the towels and bed linens (laundry room is on second floor). Put towels and bed linens in dryer and run it before you leave.
2. Turn off the hot water heater.
3. Turn off the air conditioner.
4. Turn off all lights.
5. Un-plug in all the TV's and other electronic appliances.
6. Make sure that the oven and stove (all appliances) are turned off (except for the dryer if it is running when you leave).
7. Close and lock all windows and doors (including the utility rooms on ground floor.)
8. Close all window blinds.
9. If you used the crab traps, clean them up and store them under the stairs.
10. Vacuum the rugs. Vacuum is in the closet of the bedroom on the main floor. Sweep and mop the wood floors.
11. Close and lock all windows and doors.
12. Turn off the water at the meter.
13. Take the trash with you. The dump is on the left on your way out of Horseshoe. The dump hours are:
